On November 3, 2003, 9 'Kilopost' stamps were issued, without indicating a nominal value.

They have the same dimensions (55.32 mm x 24 mm) but come in different colors (all bi-colored). The values correspond to the 9 tiers of domestic rates for 'Kilopost' postage. Each stamp indicates the maximum weight of the shipment that can be sent with it.

They are available for purchase in two ways:

- Sheet of 10 stamps (all values)
- Booklet of 5 self-adhesive stamps (only for 0.5 kg, 1 kg, and 2 kg)

The Kilopost stamp is the perfect solution. It is red, smaller than before, and looks like a real postage stamp, which increases the impact of your shipments.

Attention! Of the 9 existing weight categories, 5 remain:

from 0.5 kg to 2 kg

from 2 kg to 5 kg

up to 10 kg

up to 20 kg

up to 30 kg

Important change! For all these categories, you only need one stamp. Depending on the category, you simply attach one or more stamps. It couldn't be simpler!

How do you frank your Kilopost Standard shipment?□

Your Kilopost Standard shipment can be franked with the "Kilopost Standard stamps."

Shipments can be sent with a postage label that you obtain at a post office or Post Point. The number of stamps you need to affix depends on the weight, destination of the package, and the chosen treatment (Priority mailbox and those that do not fit in it or Non-Priority). The Kilopost Standard stamp is available in two versions: Priority and Economy, both of which are green.

Kilopost is divided into 3 different files:

- Ki-Kilopost stamps - O : The stamps with the booklets (B)
- Ki-Kilopost stamps - U : The stamps without the booklets (B)
- Kilopost stamps -V10 : The leaves V10 of the stamps
