


Various types of MCs

According to OSC, there are two different MK models from No. 2183 to No. 3546, namely:

- MK max: manufactured by Max-Belgium, logo:




designation in the OSC catalogue: [►mb◄](#)



- MK mb: published by the Belgian Association of Maximists; logo:




The differences are not noticeable on the front, but can be seen on the back due to the logos mentioned above

Although, based on the markings, [►max◄](#) or [►mb◄](#) these MKs may also be from other publishers, including ▼

However, there are also MKs from other publishers not listed in OBP, namely:

This MK catalogue makes no distinction, and the MKs of the various types are therefore shown together


From the 1972 issue (No. 1621) (??) onwards, there are MC in silk issued by Sony (Sony Stamps)
These were issued up to and including the 2005 issue (No. 3431) (??)

These are usually listed on the right-hand side of this catalogue under:

Sony => issued "Sony" (Sony Stamps)
