

INTRODUCTION inventory lists "Special Purpose Stamps"

MZ

In these lists, you will find all the stamps classified by issue dates.

They are arranged in different series with the OBP numbers (some exceptionally different).

In these lists, you will find the inventory of the various so-called "special purpose stamps" of Belgium. These

"special purpose stamps" are also referred to as "annexes."

There are 2 lists:

- Invent.(EN) BA-JO-Ki-KP-KT-M-OC-PA-S-TE-TG-TR-TRV-TX.xlsx
- Invent.(EN) PRE1-PRE838.xlsx

They are all alphabetically arranged according to the albums of the different types in an Excel file.

Collectors can create PDF files from them as needed.

The italic numbers or notes are not mentioned in the OBP.

On the left side, the missing stamps in the different albums are indicated by "MZ."

All missing stamps are grouped in the worksheet "Missing" except for PRE: these are located in 'Missing PRE'

(For personal use, you can remove the "A" columns in each worksheet + worksheet "Missing" - "Missing PRE").

Use of the inventory

All lists are password protected and can therefore be unlocked at any time.

When unlocked, a row can always be added at your convenience: the formulas adjust automatically.

In a secured state, only the green cells can be edited if necessary to complete your inventory on the right.

On the right, the columns (from row O) are divided into:

In columns O ► AB, there are formulas in the cells that are automatically updated when data is entered in the green cells (not secured).

Rows & columns can be added on the left without disrupting the function of the formulas (unlocking).

- Mint and used stamps – and also divided into single or double possession.
- On the far right, you can optionally fill in the value of the stamps (by reference date).
- If not in use, you can remove these columns without issues (V ► AA).

If errors occur in the formulas, they can be easily adjusted.

Furthermore, these lists are very clear and do not require further explanation.
