What are Maximum Cards?

In simple terms, maximum cards are postcards with a stamp affixed to them that matches the theme of the image on the card. The stamp is cancelled on the card itself, ideally with a postmark that is also relevant to the theme. What makes them special to collectors is the combination of stamp, image and postmark, which together form a unique and often rare philatelic item.

The Value of a Maximum Card

The value of a maximum card is determined by several factors, including the rarity of the stamp, the quality of the image, the relevance of the postmark, and the overall condition of the card. Certain themes (such as historical events or famous people), rare stamps or postmarks, and cards in perfect condition make them more valuable to collectors.

Storage tips for Maximum cards

albums. Avoid direct sunlight and high humidity to prevent discolouration and damage. Handle the cards with care and avoid touching the image or stamp to prevent fingerprints and other damage.
